

Punjab CM Inaugurates L&T's Rajpura Thermal Power Plant

The first unit of the 2x700 MW supercritical Rajpura Thermal Power Plant of L&T inaugurated was December 08, 2013 by Punjab Chief Minister, Mr. Parkash Singh Badal, at a function attended by Dy. Chief Minister, Mr. Sukhbir Singh Badal, prominent state leaders, senior officials and Shailendra Roy, Wholetime Director & Sr. **EVP** (Corporate Affairs & Power), L&T.

The plant, located near Nalash village in Patiala District of Punjab, is the first major coal-fired power plant to be owned and operated by L&T through a Special Purpose Vehicle - Nabha Power Limited. Coal supply for the Rajpura power plant has been secured through a fuel supply agreement with South Eastern Coalfields. The entire power will be supplied to the state of Punjab.

In addition to the supercritical boiler and turbine generator, L&T also supplied balance of plant equipment, electrostatic precipitators, coal and ash handling plants, chimney, cooling tower, control & automation equipment and switchyard.

Speaking on the occasion, Mr. Shailendra Roy said: "We are proud to have completed the project on schedule. With this launch, we have demonstrated our capability of constructing a large supercritical power plant. L&T Power has projects totaling 11000 MW currently under implementation on EPC basis for different customers in various parts of the country."
