

L&T Among the Only Five Indian Companies in Global CDR Report

L&T has secured a place among the only five Indian companies in Global Carbon Disclosure Report (CDR) 2014 - annual assessment of Green House Gas (GHG) emissions and climate change strategies of companies - conducted by UK-based Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP). This distinction acknowledges L&T's contribution to the cause of climatic change and its efforts to keep abreast with regulatory changes.

The survey covered the leading 2000 companies (based on market capitalization) globally.

The CDP (formerly Carbon Disclosure Project) is the only global system for companies and cities to measure, disclose, manage and share vital environmental information. CDP works with investors globally to advance the investment



opportunities and reduce the risks posed by climate change by asking over 5,000 of the world's largest companies to report their climate strategies, GHG emissions and energy use through CDP's standardized format.

Each year, participants' responses are analyzed and scored against two parallel scoring schemes: performance and disclosure. This report focuses solely on performance and includes only those companies that enter the Climate Performance Leadership Index (CPLI) and achieve the highest 'A' band.
